David Lamar Singleton, 74, passed away on June 29, 2019. Born and raised in Central Florida, David lived for several years in Arizona and Texas, and then returned to Orlando, where he has lived for the past 30-plus years. He graduated from Colonial High School and Florida State University. He was a veteran of the United States Air Force, in which he attained the rank of Lieutenant. He retired from the security department of Florida Hospital.
