George E Larson 82, of Orlando, passed away Saturday, June 10, 2017. George served in the United States Air Force for 21 years. He was most proud of the year that he served with the Rustics.

George was asked to volunteer for a job that was “highly classified and quite dangerous”. Within hours of arrival at his new base, George, who had spent his entire time in the Air Force in administrative positions, found himself strapped into the back seat of a small 2-person plane, flying low and slow over enemy forces while being shot at! His job was to act as interpreter between his pilot and Cambodian troops on the ground. While this continued almost every day for a year, George was more than up for the task: He made himself a valuable member of the Rustics by becoming far more than an interpreter, respected and well thought-of by others. In his later years, George retained many fond memories of his service with these brave men.

George is survived by his loving wife of 45 years, Mucha K Larson; son, Charles A. Larson; Sister, Susan Oatley Dixon; and brother, Eugene Dixon.

George was a loving husband and father who could never say “No”. He was always ready to lend a helping hand or a sympathetic ear. He will be remembered fondly and missed by many.
