



Hubert Ronald Singer Jr.

October 24, 1939 - August 17, 2021

Captain Hubert "Ron" Singer was born in Florida on October 24, 1939, and had a wonderful, exciting, and colorful life.

Ron attended Miami Edison Senior High School and studied at the University of Miami.

He served his country during the Korean War in the 1950's and was a stunt man and handsome Hollywood escort for the stars throughout the 60's. Ron was an accountant for Capitol Records in the 70's when he met his first mate and friend for life, Henry (1970).

For over 50 years they traveled the world as partners taking their motorhome coast to coast RVing America's highways. After exploring the United States, they set their sights on more adventures... this time the open seas.

Ron then bought a sailboat, the S/V Allons (French for "let's go") which he moored in Coconut Grove, Florida. Using celestial navigation, Ron captained the Allons from Dinner Key Marina to Newport, Rhode Island, for America's Bicentennial celebration in 1976. Soon after Ron established Sailorman Charters, as a private business for sailing charters throughout the Bahamas. Ron and Henry also crewed for private yacht owners which lead them to Italy, exploring Europe and the Mediterranean. Another job took them down to the

Caribbean Islands, including Martinique and St. Martin for several years.

After years on the water, Ron became a Deputy Clerk of Circuit Court in Miami, Florida. Following retirement, he and Henry settled north of Orlando in Apopka, Florida, dancing the nights away, going to amusement parks and festivals, and embracing a good time, wherever it might be.

Ron touched many, many lives in his 81 years making so many beautiful eternal friends along the way. Although he will be sorely missed, he is at peace now. His favorite quote, "Yesterday is history, tomorrow is a mystery, and today is a gift. That's why they call it the 'present.'"

Ron is survived by his life-long partner, Henry Perez; sister, Clara Singer Noble; and niece, Jennifer Noble Gilley. According to Ron's wishes, there will be no service and he will be cremated.
