Leroy Bellamy, Jr. of Orlando, Florida, was born in Inverness, Florida on March 17, 1938, to his parents, Pastor Leroy Bellamy, Sr. and Evangelist Priscilla Bellamy. After High School Leroy enlisted in the Air Force and served 20 years as an Air Traffic Controller. Upon retiring from the military Mr. Bellamy completed four years of Extensive Wells Fargo Computer training in one year and then he became Vice President of Systems for Wells Fargo Bank, in San Francisco California. After 18 years of working for Wells Fargo and barely missing the destruction from the 1988 earthquake out in San Francisco, California, Leroy made a life change and decided it was time to change banks and focus on his family.

Leroy was a man of God, loved by many, a great husband and father who constantly prayed blessings over his family. He is survived by the love of his life, his wife of 68 years, Earlene Bellamy of Orlando, Florida; 3 sons: Leroy Bellamy III, of California, Curtis L. Bellamy of Orlando, Florida, and Jeffrey Bellamy of Pembroke Pines, Florida; 4 siblings, Lucille White of Detroit, Michigan, Randolph (Gladys) Bellamy, Sr. of Inverness, Florida., Lonnie (Helena) Bellamy, Sr. of Woodbridge, Virginia, Gilbert (Canaveral) Bellamy of Texas; 4 grandchildren, LeKeshia Bellamy of California, Justin Bellamy of Lakeland, Florida, Blair Bellamy of Hot Springs, Arkansas, and Jasmine Bellamy of Hot Springs, Arkansas; and 1 great grandchild, Nima-Soleil Bellamy of California; and a host of nieces and nephews.
