



Luis Miguel Aponte Gomez "Uvita"

Luis Miguel Aponte Gómez, alias "Uvita" —conocido con gran afecto por familiares y amigos por su espíritu aventurero y su corazón generoso— falleció el 23 de mayo de 2026, a la edad de 35 años.
