From there, he attended Liberty University, earning his master's degree in human services counseling. He spent the rest of his life working as a substance abuse counselor at Central Florida Treatment Center and Aspire Health Partners, and recently as a psychosocial rehabilitation specialist for Positive Behavioral Solutions. He went above and beyond for his clients as he loved helping people. He is survived by his wife, Courtney Dyer, daughter, Kendall Dyer, stepson Jordan Adorno, sister Katrina, mother-in-law, Brenda Horne, father-in-law, Steve Horne, his chihuahua Lulu, his uncle Bruce Dyer, uncle Reginald Dyer, Aunt Brenda Reynolds, and many beloved

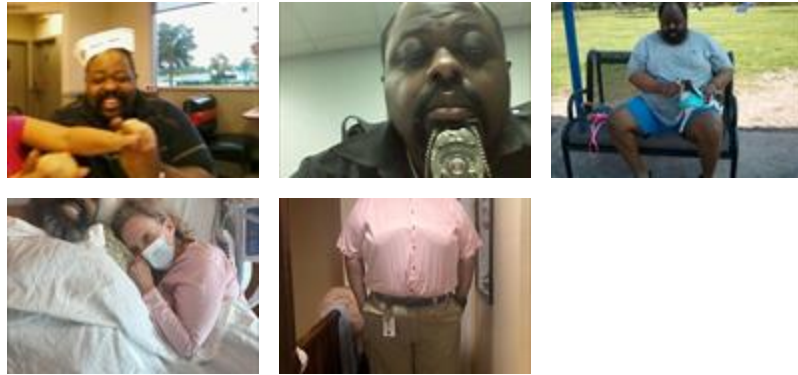

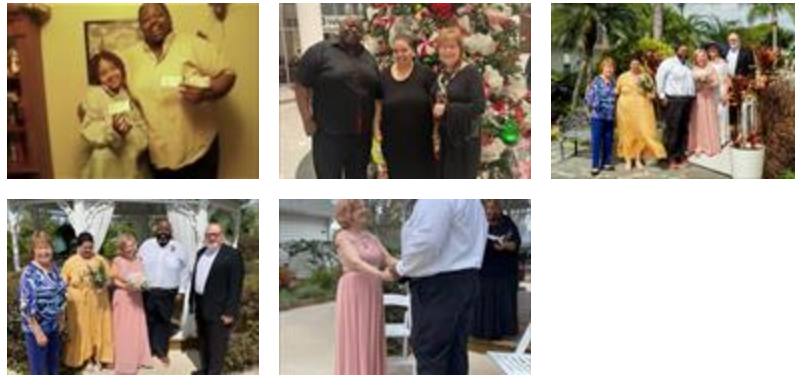
