passed away.

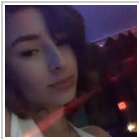

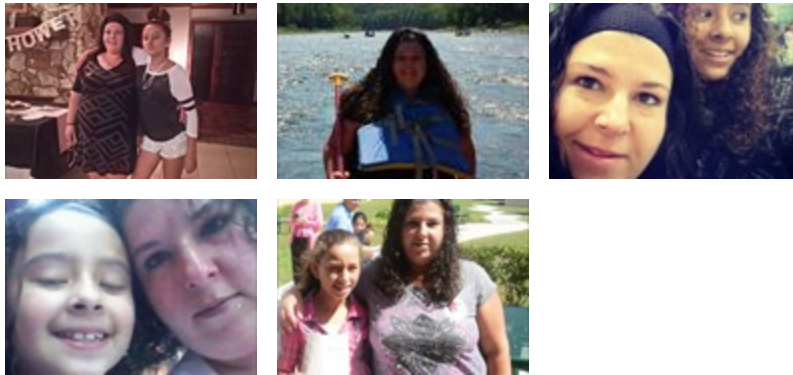
