Mark Keyser-Ziegler, 43, of Orlando, Florida passed away on June 11, 2017 after being the victim of a vehicular accident while he was a pedestrian. Mark was born on February 25, 1974 in New Britain, Connecticut. He was the youngest of what became a total of eight siblings.

He is predeceased by his father, Dr. Edmund F. Ziegler; his mother, Lorraine A. Ziegler as well as two brothers, Francis X. Ziegler and Kevin T. Ziegler.

Mark is survived by his loving husband, Kevin Keyser-Ziegler, of Orlando, Florida; and three brothers, Thomas Ziegler of Torrington, Connecticut; Phillip Ziegler of New Britain, Connecticut; James Ziegler of Plainville, Connecticut; and two sisters, Suzanne Ghiloni of Braintree, Massachusetts; and Mary Ziegler Carpenter of Plainville, Connecticut. Mark is also survived by many nieces, nephews, grand nieces, grand nephews, uncles, aunts, cousins and other family members from around the United States.

Mark worked for the Walt Disney Company since 1990 in various capacities but mostly as an Entertainment Manager. He is known for his sparkling, outgoing and happy, positive personality, caring for the individual person, and the love he had for the work he did and the people with whom he worked.

Since he left in 2013, Mark's legacy continues with the people he had mentored, taught, and trained moving onward to better their careers. Mark is survived by that community of talented professionals all over the world.

Mark and his husband, Kevin Keyser-Ziegler, were married on February 27, 2012 in New Britain, Connecticut and after celebrating a 5 year wedding anniversary this year, were about to celebrate a 17 year anniversary of being together this July. Together, they published three cookbooks called "Cooking with Kevin & Mark" and filmed a cooking show episode for PBS "Real Food, Real Kitchens" in 2009. Mark has also contributed to the television show's magazine with articles and features.

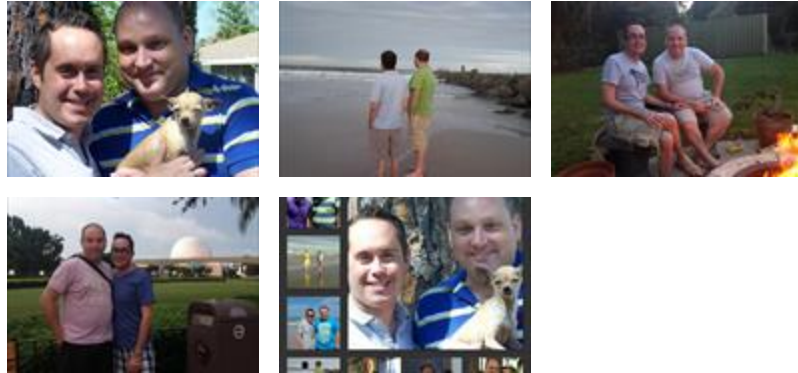

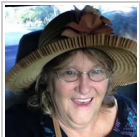

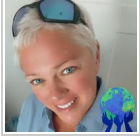
