Nancy Louise Barkus, 75, won the good fight and inherited her eternal crown on January 25, 2019, surrounded by her family. She is now spending eternity with her Creator, the Savior of the world and true lover of her soul. Anything she may have had to go through over the years that tried her emotionally, physically and spiritually lost any sting the moment she stepped into the full Glory of His presence.

Born in Pottstown, PA on June 5, 1943, she was the daughter of the late Lloyd E. and Frances Stauffer. Nancy lived a full and dedicated life to giving all she had to offer to others. With each year that passed, God gave her more and more love to give. She loved people and people loved her. From her children's teenage friends, the customers at her restaurant (Carolina BBQ) to literally, people around the world in 67 countries. Her life was a testament of God's unrelenting Love, His power to Heal and His devotion to restore. He took the broken pieces of her life and transformed her into a fully restored master piece, a beacon of Hope and Love to everyone around her. Perth, Australia for 6 months. After DTS, she went into full time Missions and served 5 years in Thailand. In 2010, she came home and was blessed to care for her mother along side her sister, Lila Mae “Dolly” Brauen. Nancy served as the Missions Board Director at her home church, Calvary Assembly of God, where she also volunteered 3 days a week.

She enjoyed loving people, leading missions teams, traveling and spending quality time with family and friends. She planted seeds in many hearts, watered even more and they are still bearing fruit today. She will be missed dearly.

Nancy is survived by her children; Robert Arthur Barkus III and daughter in love, Katherine Barkus, Maria Adele Nistri, Lisa Francesca Lampkin and son in law, Dan Lampkin. Four grandchildren; Austin Billhime, Ethan Billhime, Lucy Lampkin, Danielle Lampkin, a niece, Lori Udeck and a nephew, Steven Brauen. Like her mother, Nancy was also a mother and grandmother to a host of people around the world and to her children’s friends.
