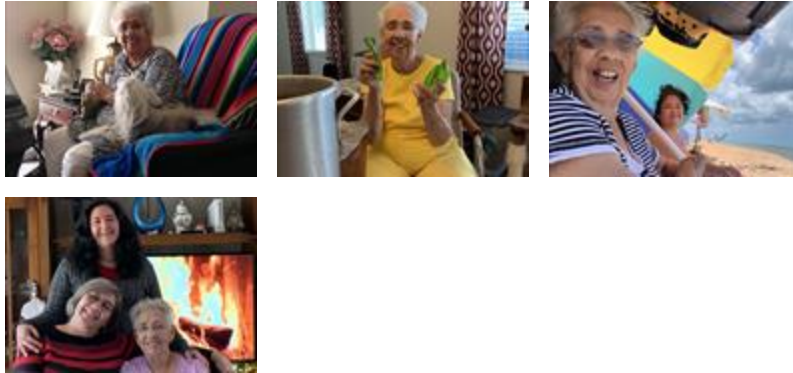
We can meet at the office in the front and head to the actual site together. If you already know where it is then we can meet you there. You can release balloons if you would like.

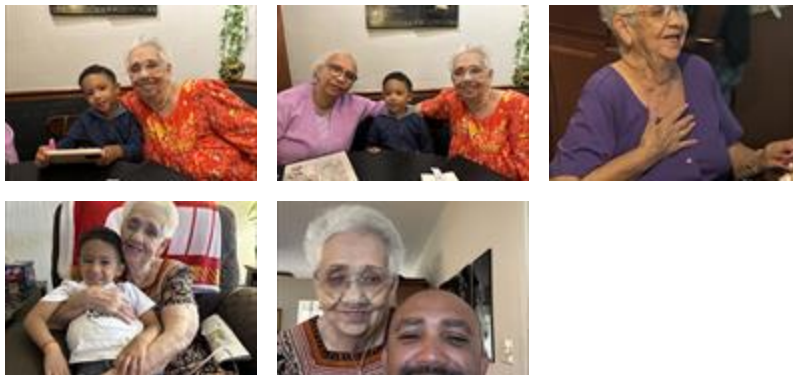
