




## Stephenie Lynn Hurd



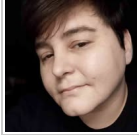

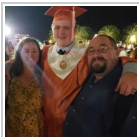
