After graduation Tom went on to Seminole Junior College to win the pole vaulting Jr. College National Championship with a record jump of 16'. He then traveled to Boone, North Carolina to study business at Appalachian State University. After college Tom was involved in his family's restaurant business. Once retired he enjoyed working with family and friends in different ventures. Tom had a love for fishing, the Florida Gators, and playing music with his father and brothers. Tom was predeceased by his wife Loanne, parents Louis and Mildred and brother Jim. He is survived by brothers Ronald Kaminer and Gregory Kaminer.
